

# MLA Report Card – Bhoa Assembly (Pathankot District)

## Overall Score:

58.1 / 100 (≈ 58%) → Grade: C+

(Average performance, moderate strengths, but significant gaps remain)

## 1. Rural Governance (PAI Scores)

- **Score:** 52.1 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

### Rural Report Card (Gram Panchayat Performance – PAI Index)

- **Blocks Covered:** Narot Jaimal Singh, Gharota, Bamial (116 GPs).
  - **Average Overall PAI:** 57.9 / 100 (C – Aspirant).
  - **Strengths:**
    - Good performance in *Healthy Panchayat* and *Child-Friendly Panchayat*.
    - Several GPs scoring 70+ in water sufficiency and poverty alleviation.
  - **Weaknesses:**
    - **Infrastructure & Social Justice** scores remain low (often <50).
    - **Women-Friendly Panchayat** weak, averaging ~50–55.
  - **Interpretation:** Rural governance shows *average performance*, with clear gaps in inclusivity and infrastructure.

## 2. Urban Governance

### (a) Health – Pathankot District HQ (relevant to Bhoa)

- **Score:** 5 / 7

- **Strengths:**
  - ICU available in only 5 DHs in Punjab (Pathankot is not among them, but proximity to Gurdaspur DH helps).
  - Surplus specialists (+60%) and OPD coverage functional.
  - Full line services (emergency, pathology, imaging, oxygen, mortuary) operational.
- **Weaknesses:**
  - **Doctor shortage:** 1 per ~5,600 population vs state avg 1:3,857.
  - **Nurse vacancies** high (75% vacant at Bhoa PHC).
  - **No ICU** at Pathankot DH, unlike Gurdaspur.
  - **Low PMJAY registration** (~43%).

## (b) Housing – Nagrota Jaimal Singh TP (PMAY-U)

- **Score:** 1 / 3
- **Data:**
  - Houses Sanctioned: 226
  - Grounded: 130 (58%)
  - Completed: 26 (11.5%)
  - Central Assistance Released: ₹1.04 Cr (out of ₹3.39 Cr sanctioned).
- **Interpretation:** Housing delivery is weak, with **very low completion** and **poor fund utilization**.

### □ Strengths

- Reasonable PAI scores in health & child-related themes.
- Grounding of more than half sanctioned PMAY houses.
- District health services functional with OPDs and line services.

### ● Weaknesses

- Low PMAY housing completion (just 26/226 units).
- Rural Panchayats weak in social justice, women's inclusion, infrastructure.
- Shortage of nurses and doctors in Pathankot DH/PHCs.
- PMJAY outreach below state average.

### □ Recommendations

1. **Accelerate PMAY completions** – focus on converting grounded houses into finished units.
2. **Strengthen PHCs in Bhoa block** by filling nurse and paramedic vacancies.
3. **Boost PMJAY registration drives** to cover eligible beneficiaries.
4. Focus on **social justice & gender inclusion** at GP level.
5. **Infrastructure upgradation** in rural Panchayats (roads, sanitation, community spaces).
