

# MLA Report Card – Qadian Assembly

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## Overall Score:

54.1 / 100 ( $\approx$  54%) → Grade: C

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## Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI):** 47.1 / 90
  - **Urban Health (Gurdaspur DH + CHCs in Qadian/Dhariwal/Kahnuwan):** 5 / 7
  - **Urban Housing (PMAY-U Qadian Municipality):** 2 / 3
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## 1. Rural Governance (PAI Scores)

- **Coverage:** 125 Gram Panchayats (Dhariwal Block).
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 52.3 / 100.
- **Normalized MLA Score:** 47.1 / 90.
- **Status:** C – Aspirant.

### Strengths:

- Good scores in *Child-Friendly Panchayat* and *Water Sufficiency*.
- A few Panchayats (e.g., Satkoha, Faizullah Chak) in *A category*.

### Weaknesses:

- Majority Panchayats remain *C (Aspirant)*.
  - Weakness in *Infrastructure, Women-Friendly Panchayat, and Social Security*.
  - Governance accountability (Gram Sabha meetings, transparency) inconsistent.
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## 2. Health (Gurdaspur District – relevant to Qadian Assembly)

- **Score:** 5 / 7

### Key Findings:

- **District Hospital Gurdaspur:**

- ICU available (1 of only 5 in Punjab).
- Surplus doctors (+21%) and specialists (+60%).
- Severe **bed shortage (75%)**.
- PMJAY enrolment ~36% of eligible.
- **Qadian CHC:** Doctors –75%, Nurses –27%, Others –46%.
- **Dhariwal CHC:** Doctors adequate, but nurses –6%, paramedics –33%, others –83%.
- **Kahnuwan CHC:** Doctors –27%, Nurses –36%, Others –63%.

**Interpretation:** Strong in ICU, doctors & specialists, but serious shortages in nurses, beds, and PMJAY coverage.

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### 3. Housing (PMAY-U – Qadian Municipality)

- **Score:** 2 / 3

#### Data:

- Investment: ₹10.45 Cr
- Central Assistance Sanctioned: ₹4.27 Cr
- Released: ₹2.12 Cr (~50%)
- Houses Sanctioned: 300
- Grounded: 214 (71%)
- Completed: 149 (50%)

**Interpretation:** Moderate performance – **half houses completed** and strong grounding rate, but funds underutilized.

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#### Strengths

- ICU at DH Gurdaspur, surplus doctors/specialists.
- Half PMAY houses completed; grounding rate strong.
- Panchayats moderately strong in *child & water sufficiency themes*.

#### ● Weaknesses

- **75% bed shortage** at DH Gurdaspur.
- Shortage of nurses and support staff in CHCs.
- PMJAY registration low (~36%).
- Panchayats weak in *infrastructure, women empowerment, and social justice*.

#### Recommendations

1. Urgently expand **bed capacity** in DH Gurdaspur.
2. Fill **nurse and support staff vacancies** in Qadian, Dhariwal, and Kahnuwan CHCs.

3. Improve **PMJAY enrolment drives**.
  4. Accelerate **completion of remaining PMAY houses**.
  5. Strengthen Panchayats in **infrastructure and gender inclusivity**.
