

MLA Report Card – Sujapur Assembly

Overall Score:

57.3 / 100 (≈ 57%) → Grade: C+
(Average performance with visible gaps in delivery)

Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI):** 51.8 / 90
 - **Urban Health (Pathankot DH & PHCs/CHCs):** 4 / 7
 - **Urban Housing (PMAY-U Sujapur):** 1.5 / 3
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1. Rural Governance (PAI Scores)

- **Score:** 51.8 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Rural Report Card (PAI Index)

- **Blocks Covered:** Sujapur (78 GPs) + Dhar Kalan (27 GPs) = 105 GPs.
 - **Average Overall PAI:** 57.6 / 100.
 - **Strengths:**
 - High scores in *Child-Friendly Panchayat* (many GPs above 85).
 - *Healthy Panchayat* and *Water Sufficiency* themes are consistently strong.
 - **Weaknesses:**
 - **Infrastructure & Social Justice:** scores often below 50.
 - **Women-Friendly Panchayat:** low scores (~50–55).
 - **Interpretation:** Rural Panchayats are **average performers**, stronger in health & child welfare but weak in inclusivity and infrastructure.
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2. Urban Governance

(a) Health – Pathankot District

- **Score:** 4 / 7
- **Strengths:**
 - Doctors posted in most PHCs (Kathlaur, Taragarh, Bhoa, etc.).
 - OPD and basic services functional.

- **Weaknesses:**
 - **Severe nurse & paramedic shortages** (0–50% staff in many PHCs).
 - **PMJAY registration** only ~46% of eligible population.
 - No ICU at Pathankot DH.

(b) Housing – Sujanpur Municipality (PMAY-U)

- **Score:** 1.5 / 3
 - **Data:**
 - Houses Sanctioned: 830
 - Grounded: 611 (74%)
 - Completed: 297 (36%)
 - Central Assistance Released: ₹7.06 Cr out of ₹11.99 Cr (59%)
 - **Interpretation: Good grounding rate, but low completion** (36%), leaving >500 houses pending.
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□ Strengths

- Panchayats strong in *child welfare, health, and water sufficiency*.
- Majority of sanctioned PMAY houses grounded.
- Doctors mostly available in PHCs.

● Weaknesses

- Low PMAY completions (36%).
- Nurse/paramedic shortages at PHCs.
- PMJAY registration below 50%.
- Weak GP performance in infrastructure, women’s inclusion, and social justice.

□ Recommendations

1. Accelerate **PMAY house completions** to reduce backlog.
 2. Fill **nurse & paramedic vacancies** in PHCs/CHCs.
 3. Improve **PMJAY enrolment & awareness**.
 4. Strengthen Panchayat efforts in **infrastructure, social equity, and women’s empowerment**.
