- Majority clustered near **50–56**, keeping the block in *Aspirant band*.
 - Weakness in **social justice, women participation, and infrastructure**.
 - Wide variation between high and low performers.

- **Score:** 5 / 7

Strengths:

- **Beds:** 470 available out of 603 required (22% shortage → better than many districts).

- **Doctors:** Good sanctioned strength, ratio better than Punjab average.
- **OPD and diagnostic facilities** fully functional.

Weaknesses:

- Still a **22% bed shortage**.
 - Shortage of **specialists** (dermatology, anaesthesia, paediatrics).
 - **No sanctioned dietician or lab attendants.**

- **Score:** 2 / 3

Data:

- Houses Sanctioned: 255
- Houses Grounded: 140 (55%)
- Houses Completed: 134 (53%)
- Central Assistance Released: 2.42 Cr (~59% of sanctioned)

Interpretation: Moderate progress — >50% completions, but not yet high-performing.

✓ Strengths

- Relatively strong **doctor-patient ratio** in Jalandhar DH.
- More than half of sanctioned PMAY houses completed.

- Rural governance still in **Aspirant band**.
 - **Specialist shortages** and staff gaps at Jalandhar DH.
 - PMAY housing still below **60% completion**.
