

# MLA Report Card – Amargarh Assembly

## Overall Score:

56.3 / 100 → Grade: C (Performer/Aspirant Borderline)

## Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI – Amargarh Block):** 51.7 / 90
  - **Health (Malerkotla DH + Amargarh CHC):** 4 / 7
  - **Housing (PMAY-U – Amargarh, Town Panchayat):** 2 / 3

## Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 42
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 57.4 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 51.7 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

### Strengths:

- Several Panchayats achieved *Performer* status (>60).
- Themes like **Child-Friendly Panchayat** and **Clean & Green Panchayat** performed relatively well.

### Weaknesses:

- Average below 60 keeps Amargarh in Aspirant band.
  - Persistent issues in **Infrastructure, Women-Friendly Panchayat, Social Justice.**

## Health Report Card (Malerkotla DH + Amargarh CHC)

- **Score:** 4 / 7

### Strengths:

- Malerkotla DH offers OPD, imaging, pathology, and emergency services.
- Ambulance services operational.

#### Weaknesses:

- **40% bed shortage** (180 vs 300 required).
  - Shortage of **specialists, nurses, paramedics**.
  - **ICU not fully functional**.
  - Peripheral CHCs/PHCs under-equipped.

## 🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Amargarh, Town Panchayat)

- **Score: 2 / 3**

#### Data:

- Houses Sanctioned: 99
- Grounded: 82 (83%)
- Completed: 42 (42%)

**Interpretation:** High grounding, but only moderate completion → score of 2.

### ✓ Strengths

- Panchayats show progress in child-friendly and clean-green themes.
- Malerkotla DH provides a reasonable backbone of services.
- PMAY-U grounding rate is strong (>80%).

### ✗ Weaknesses

- Rural average stuck in the **Aspirant band**.
  - Major health staff shortages & limited ICU capacity.
  - Housing completions lag behind grounding.
-
