- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 50

Strengths:

- A few Panchayats crossed 60+ into *Performer* category.
- Positive results in **Child-Friendly Panchayat** and **Clean & Green Panchayat** themes.

Weaknesses:

- Assembly-wide average stuck in **Aspirant band** (<60).
 - Gaps in **Infrastructure, Social Justice, Women-Friendly Panchayat**.
 - Large variation between higher- and lower-performing Panchayats.

Health Report Card (Fatehgarh Sahib DH + Amloh CHCs)

- **Score:** 4 / 7

Strengths:

- OPD, pathology, imaging, and emergency services functional at DH.
- Acts as referral hub for Amloh.
- Ambulances available (though under-staffed).

Weaknesses:

- **44% bed shortage** (140 available vs 250 required).
 - Shortages of **specialists, nurses, and paramedics**.
 - **ICU not functional**.
 - CHCs/PHCs under-equipped with diagnostics.

🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Amloh Municipality)

- **Score:** 3 / 3

Data:

- Houses Sanctioned: 502
- Grounded: 450 (90%)
- Completed: 385 (77%)

Interpretation: Strong housing performance → **full marks (3/3)**.

✓ Strengths

- PMAY-U housing success with >75% completions.
- District hospital provides core services despite gaps.
- Some Panchayats moving towards *Performer* status.

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural governance average still **below 60**.
 - Major shortages in healthcare staff & ICU capacity.
 - Uneven performance across Panchayats.
