

MLA Report Card – Bhadaur Assembly

Overall Score:

~49.8 / 100 → Grade: C (Aspirant)

Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 15 (Sehna Block)
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 52.90 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 48 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Strengths:

- GPs like **Nainewal (60.03)**, **Leelo (56.89)** show relatively better performance.
- Some GPs nearing Performer band.

Weaknesses:

- Overall average (52.9) → well below state average.
 - Many GPs in Aspirant/low Performer band.
 - Weakness in **infrastructure, women-friendly governance, social justice.**

Health Report Card (Barnala DH & Bhadaur CHC)

- **MLA Health Score:** 4 / 7
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Strengths:

- Beds adequate at Barnala DH (160 available vs 164 required).
- CHC Bhadaur has partial staffing.

Weaknesses:

- **Doctors:** 34% shortage at DH, 67% shortage at CHC.
 - **Nurses:** 37% shortage at DH, 25% shortage at CHC.
 - **Paramedics & other staff:** Large gaps.
 - **ICU facility missing**, no audits conducted.

🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Bhadaur Municipality)

- **Houses Sanctioned:** 1,108
- **Grounded:** 1,052 (95%)
- **Completed:** 301 (27%)
- **MLA Housing Score:** 1 / 3
- **Status:** D – Weak

Interpretation: While grounding is high, **completion is very poor** (less than one-third).

✓ Strengths

- Beds at Barnala DH nearly adequate.
- Some Panchayats in Sehna Block close to Performer level.
- PMAY-U grounding is strong (95%).

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural score only **48/90** → Aspirant grade.
 - **Severe staff shortages** in doctors, nurses, paramedics.
 - ICU facilities and medical audits absent.
 - Housing completion under PMAY-U very weak (301/1108).
