Overall Score:

56.2 / 100 → Grade: C (Aspirant/Performer borderline)

Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI – Chamkaur Sahib + Morinda Blocks):** 49.5 / 90
 - **Health (Rupnagar DH + Chamkaur Sahib/Morinda CHCs):** 4 / 7
 - **Housing (PMAY-U – Chamkaur Sahib & Morinda ULBs):** 3 / 3
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Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 115
 - Morinda Block: 53 GPs
 - Chamkaur Sahib Block: 62 GPs
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 54.96 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 49.5 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Strengths:

- Chamkaur Sahib block GPs performing better (several above 60).
- Themes like **Child-Friendly Panchayat** and **Clean & Green Panchayat** relatively stronger.
- A few Panchayats entered *Front Runner* band.

Weaknesses:

- Morinda block’s lower average (≈ 52) drags down overall performance.
 - Governance, Social Justice, and Women-Friendly Panchayat themes underperform.
 - High variation between Panchayats.
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Health Report Card (Rupnagar DH + Chamkaur Sahib & Morinda CHCs)

- **Score:** 4 / 7

Strengths:

- Rupnagar DH offers OPD, diagnostics, pathology, and emergency services.
- Ambulance services present and functional.
- Referral hub for Chamkaur Sahib & Morinda.

Weaknesses:

- **43% bed deficit** at DH.
 - **ICU non-functional**; critical patients referred outside district.
 - Shortages of **specialists, nurses, and paramedics**.
 - Peripheral CHCs under-equipped.
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🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Chamkaur Sahib & Morinda)

- **Score:** 3 / 3

Chamkaur Sahib (Town Panchayat):

- Houses Sanctioned: 441 → Completed: 294 (67%) → Score: 2/3

Morinda (Municipality):

- Houses Sanctioned: 402 → Completed: 327 (81%) → Score: 3/3

→ Overall: **3/3** (good performance with one ULB above 80%).

✓ Strengths

- Good urban housing performance (especially Morinda).
- Rupnagar DH ensures core hospital services.
- Some Panchayats performing strongly in green and child-friendly themes.

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural average still in **Aspirant band (<60)**.
 - Health infrastructure gaps: ICU non-functional, staff shortages.
 - Uneven GP performance across blocks.
