

## MLA Report Card – Dera Baba Nanak Assembly (Gurdaspur District)

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Overall Score:

**52.4 / 100 (≈ 52%) → Grade: C+**

*(Average performance with select strengths, but major gaps remain)*

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### Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI):** 45.9 / 90
  - **Urban Health (Gurdaspur DH):** 5 / 7
  - **Urban Housing (PMAY-U Dera Baba Nanak):** 1.5 / 3
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#### 1. Rural Governance (PAI Scores)

- **Score:** 45.9 / 90
- **Status:** *C – Aspirant*

#### Rural Report Card (Gram Panchayat Performance – PAI Index)

- **Overall Average:** ~51/100 (*C – Aspirant*).
- **Better Performing Themes:**
  - **Child-Friendly Panchayat:** Multiple GPs scored 80+ (*Front Runner*).
  - **Healthy Panchayat:** Generally in 60–70 range (*Performer*).
  - **Water Sufficiency:** Many Panchayats at performer level.
- **Weaker Themes:**
  - **Self-Sufficient Infrastructure:** Low scores, ~40–45 (*Aspirant/Beginner*).
  - **Social Justice & Security:** Weak delivery, ~45–50 (*Aspirant*).
  - **Women-Friendly Panchayat:** Mostly aspirant level, ~50–55.

→ **Interpretation:** Panchayats are *average*, with strengths in health and child welfare, but **lagging in infrastructure, social equity, and gender inclusion.**

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#### 2. Urban Governance

##### (a) Health – District HQ (Gurdaspur City)

- **Score:** 5 / 7
- **Strengths:**
  - ICU available (one of only 5 DHs in Punjab).
  - Surplus doctors & specialists (+21% overall, +60% specialists).

- Full OPD coverage & all line services (emergency, pathology, imaging, oxygen, mortuary).
- **Weaknesses:**
  - **75% bed shortage** (only 110 beds against 446 required).
  - **PMJAY registration at ~36%** of eligible population.
  - Nurses (-23%) and paramedics (-8%) below requirement.

## (b) Housing – Dera Baba Nanak Municipality (PMAY-U)

- **Score:** 1.5 / 3
- **Data:**
  - Houses Sanctioned: 308
  - Grounded: 200 (~65%)
  - Completed: 99 (~32%)
  - Central Assistance Released: ~54.8% of sanctioned
- **Interpretation:** Implementation gaps → only 1 in 3 sanctioned houses completed.

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### 📌 Strengths

- ICU and surplus specialists at Gurdaspur DH.
- Panchayats show relative strength in health, water sufficiency, and child-friendly measures.
- Housing program shows moderate grounding progress.

### ● Weaknesses

- **Severe bed shortage** at district hospital.
- **PMAY-U weak** — only 32% completion.
- **Rural governance weak** in infrastructure, women’s empowerment, and social equity.
- **PMJAY enrolment low** (~36%).

### 📌 Recommendations

1. Expand **bed capacity & staff** at Gurdaspur DH.
2. Accelerate **PMAY housing completion** with better fund utilization.
3. Strengthen **panchayat infrastructure and gender inclusion**.
4. Run **PMJAY awareness drives** to increase registration.
5. Focus on **social justice schemes** at Gram Panchayat level.
