## Overall Score:

54.99 / 100 ( $\approx 55\%$ ) → Grade: C (Aspirant)

## Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI – Garhshankar Block):** 49.49 / 90
  - **Health (Hoshiarpur DH + CHC Garhshankar):** 4 / 7
  - **Housing (PMAY-U Garhshankar Municipality):** 1.5 / 3

## Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 120
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 54.99 / 100
- **Normalized MLA Score:** 49.49 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

### Strengths:

- Some Panchayats scored 60+ in **Healthy Panchayat** and **Water Sufficiency** themes.
- A few villages did well in **Child-Friendly** and **Clean & Green** categories.

### Weaknesses:

- Majority of Panchayats remain clustered at 50–56 (*Aspirant band*).
  - **Infrastructure, social justice, and women empowerment** themes are weak.

## Health Report Card

- **Score:** 4 / 7

**Hoshiarpur DH:** Strong doctor-patient ratio, OPD functional, but **54% bed shortage** and **no ICU facility**.

**Garhshankar CHC:** OPD and maternal services available, but **40–50% staff shortages** (doctors, nurses, paramedics).

## 🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U)

- **Score:** 1.5 / 3

### Garhshankar Municipality:

- Sanctioned: 250 houses | Grounded: 150 (60%) | Completed: 118 (47%).
  - Only ~30% of sanctioned central assistance released.

## ✓ Strengths

- Panchayats strong in child and water-related indicators.
- Doctors available above state average at Hoshiarpur DH.
- Nearly half of PMAY houses completed, progress visible.

## ✗ Weaknesses

- **PAI average ~55** → Assembly stuck in *Aspirant* band.
  - **Severe bed shortage, no ICU**, and staff gaps in health infra.
  - **PMAY completions <50%**, funding release low.
