Overall Score:

55.4 / 100 (\approx 55%) → Grade: C+
(Average performance with visible delivery gaps)

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1. Rural Governance (PAI Scores)

- **Score:** 49.4 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Rural Report Card

- **Block covered:** Gidderbaha (55 GPs).
 - **Average Overall PAI Score:** 54.9 / 100.
 - **Strengths:**
 - Some Panchayats scored well in *Health, Child Welfare, Clean & Green Panchayat*.
 - **Weaknesses:**
 - **Women-Friendly Panchayat:** low scores (\sim 50).
 - **Social Security & Infrastructure:** several GPs in aspirant/beginner category.
 - **Interpretation:** Governance at the GP level is *average*, with progress in child/health-related themes but weakness in infrastructure and inclusion.
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2. Urban Governance

(a) Health – Sri Muktsar Sahib District (Gidderbaha)

- **Score:** 4.5 / 7
- **Strengths:**

- ICU available at DH Muktsar (one of only 5 districts in Punjab).
- Some PHCs like Gurusar Mandhir, Kotbhai have full sanctioned doctors.
- **Weaknesses:**
 - **Severe doctor shortages at CHCs** (up to 90% vacant in Lambi, 70–80% elsewhere).
 - **Nurse shortages** widespread (e.g., PHC Bhai Ka Khera with 0 nurses posted).
 - **PMJAY registration below state average.**
 - Beds below requirement.

(b) Housing – Gidderbaha Municipality (PMAY-U)

- **Score:** 1.5 / 3
- **Data:**
 - Houses Sanctioned: 1,435
 - Grounded: 879 (61%)
 - Completed: 548 (38%)
 - Central Assistance Released: ₹12.19 Cr of ₹21.77 Cr sanctioned (~56%)
- **Interpretation:** Moderate grounding, but **low completion rate** (38%), leaving 887 houses pending.

□ Strengths

- ICU facility at DH Muktsar.
- Some Panchayats scoring strong in health & cleanliness themes.
- Over 500 families housed under PMAY.

● Weaknesses

- **Doctor/nurse shortages** at CHCs & PHCs.
- **Housing backlog:** >60% of sanctioned PMAY houses incomplete.
- Panchayats weak in **social security, women’s inclusion, infrastructure.**
- PMJAY outreach low.

□ Recommendations

1. **Fill vacancies** in CHCs/PHCs (doctors, nurses, paramedics).
2. **Accelerate PMAY completions** to clear backlog.
3. Improve **PMJAY registration & awareness drives.**
4. Focus GP-level governance on **women empowerment & social security schemes.**
5. Improve **basic infrastructure** in Panchayats (roads, drainage, amenities).
