Strengths:

- Some Panchayats scored above 60, edging into *Performer band*.

Weaknesses:

- Assembly average still below 60, keeping it in *Aspirant band*.
 - **Infrastructure, social justice, and women’s participation** remain weak.
 - Large number of Panchayats stuck in the mid-50s.

- **Score:** 5 / 7

- **Beds:** 470 available out of 603 required (22% shortage → better than many districts).
- **Doctor–population ratio:** 1:2,801 vs Punjab average of 1:3,857.
- Full OPD, diagnostic, pathology, imaging, and emergency services available.

Weaknesses:

- **22% bed deficit.**
 - Shortages of specialists (dermatology, anaesthesia, paediatrics).
 - **No sanctioned dietician or lab attendants.**

- **Score:** 0 / 3

Reason: No PMAY-U data available for Jalandhar Cantt ULB; hence score assigned as **0**.

✓ Strengths

- Panchayats show consistent progress in sanitation and greenery themes.
- District hospital has comparatively stronger capacity than many other DHs in Punjab.

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural governance still in *Aspirant band*.
 - Specialist shortages and support staff gaps in health infrastructure.
 - No urban housing performance (0/3).
