## Overall Score:

60.6 / 100 → Grade: B (Performer)

## Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI – Malerkotla Block):** 54.5 / 90
  - **Health (Malerkotla DH):** 4 / 7
  - **Housing (PMAY-U – Malerkotla Municipality):** 2 / 3

## Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 90
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 60.5 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 54.5 / 90
- **Status:** B – Performer

### Strengths:

- Many Panchayats crossed 60, reaching *Performer* band.
- Good performance in **Child-Friendly** and **Clean & Green Panchayat** themes.
- Several Panchayats achieved 80+ scores.

### Weaknesses:

- Still variation across Panchayats; some lagging in Aspirant band (<60).
  - Weak areas: **Infrastructure, Women-Friendly Panchayat, Social Justice.**

## Health Report Card (Malerkotla District Hospital)

- **Score:** 4 / 7

### Strengths:

- OPD, diagnostics, pathology, and emergency services functional.
- Ambulance services operational.
- Acts as referral hub for Malerkotla and Amargarh.

#### Weaknesses:

- **40% bed shortage** (180 vs 300 required).
  - Shortage of specialists (anaesthesia, paediatrics, gynaecology).
  - ICU capacity limited / non-functional.
  - Nursing and paramedic staff deficits.

## 🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Malerkotla Municipality)

- **Score:** 2 / 3

#### Data:

- Houses Sanctioned: 1,215
- Grounded: 635 (52%)
- Completed: 487 (40%)

**Interpretation:** Progress moderate; strong grounding but completions remain low.

---

### ✓ Strengths

- Malerkotla Block GPs performing above 60 average (*Performer*).
- Hospital provides a broad range of services.
- Significant PMAY-U housing grounding and completions.

### ✗ Weaknesses

- Specialist and staff shortages at DH limit healthcare quality.
  - Housing completions at only 40%.
  - Rural governance has variation — not all GPs are in Performer band.
