

MLA Report Card – Mehal Kalan Assembly

Overall Score:

~58 / 100 → Grade: C+ (Aspirant–Performer Borderline)

Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** 22
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 60.32 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 54 / 90
- **Status:** B – Performer

Strengths:

- Several Panchayats are in the **Performer band** with stable governance indicators.
- Many Panchayats consistently score around **60**, showing balanced performance.
- Themes like **Clean & Green Panchayat** and **Child-Friendly Panchayat** are improving.

Weaknesses:

- Overall average (60.32) is **borderline between Aspirant and Performer**.
 - A few Panchayats are closer to the **Aspirant grade**, pulling the average down.
 - Persistent weaknesses in **Infrastructure, Women-Friendly Panchayat, and Social Justice**.

Health Report Card (Mehal Kalan CHC & Barnala DH)

- **MLA Health Score:** 4 / 7
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Strengths:

- Beds/infrastructure at CHC are adequate.
- Nurse staffing is relatively better (even surplus in some cases).

Weaknesses:

- **Doctors:** 50% shortage at CHC.
- **Paramedics:** 48% shortage.

- **ICU facility absent**, no audits conducted.
 - Governance and accountability weak.

🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U)

- **Urban Housing Coverage: Not applicable** (no Municipality/Town Panchayat under PMAY-U in Mehal Kalan).
- **MLA Housing Score: 0 / 3**
- **Status: D – Weak**

Interpretation: Mehal Kalan Assembly has no PMAY-U city coverage; housing implementation can only be tracked through **PMAY-Gramin**, not PMAY-U.

✓ Strengths

- Rural performance stable at **54/90**, many Panchayats in Performer band.
- Bed capacity at health facilities adequate.
- Nurse staffing comparatively better.

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural score still below leading assemblies (>65).
 - Health services face **major shortages in doctors, paramedics**.
 - No ICU or audits → service quality compromised.
 - **Housing score 0/3** due to lack of PMAY-U coverage.
