Strengths:

- Moderate performance in **Child-Friendly** and **Healthy Panchayat** themes.
- Some Panchayats scored 60+ in **Clean & Green** and **Water Sufficiency**.

Weaknesses:

- **Self-sufficient infrastructure** weak across most Panchayats.
 - **Women empowerment & participation** remains low (~50).
 - **Social justice & security** indicators underperform (low pension/benefits coverage).
 - Most Panchayats remain in *Aspirant* category, clustered 50–58.

Health Report Card

Score: 5 / 7

Strengths:

- **ICU available at Jalandhar DH** (among only five DHs in Punjab).

- **Surplus doctors & specialists** at Jalandhar DH (+21% overall, +60% specialists).
- **OPD & line services fully functional** (emergency, imaging, pathology, oxygen, mortuary).
- CHCs at Nakodar & Nurmahal provide general medicine, pediatrics, and maternal care.

Weaknesses:

- **22% bed shortage** at Jalandhar DH (603 required vs. 470 available).
 - **Nurses & paramedics understaffed** (-20% to -30%).
 - **PMJAY registration** below 40% of eligible citizens.
 - Lack of advanced facilities (endoscopy, cardiology, advanced radiology).

Nakodar Municipality:

- Investment: ₹29.34 Cr | Houses Sanctioned: 558
- Houses Grounded: 309 (55%) | Completed: 295 (53%)

Nurmahal Municipality:

- Investment: ₹8.69 Cr | Houses Sanctioned: 193
- Houses Grounded: 132 (68%) | Completed: 105 (54%)

Interpretation:

- Both municipalities delivered **over 50% completions**, showing moderate progress.
 - **Funding utilization lagging**: central assistance released lower than sanctioned.
 - Completion rates remain **below high-performing ULBs (70–80%)**.

✓ Strengths

- Moderate rural governance with some strong Panchayats.
- Jalandhar DH has **specialist surplus & ICU availability**.
- Over **400 PMAY houses completed** across Nakodar & Nurmahal municipalities.

✗ Weaknesses

- Most Panchayats remain *Aspirant* (average ~55).
- **Health infrastructure gaps** in nurses, paramedics, and advanced facilities.
- **Housing completion just ~50%**, needs acceleration.
