

MLA Report Card – Shahkot Assembly

Overall Score:

52.2 / 100 → Grade: C (Aspirant)

Score Breakdown

- **Rural Governance (PAI – Mehatpur, Lohian, Shahkot Blocks):** 49.2 / 90
 - **Health (Jalandhar DH):** 5 / 7
 - **Housing (PMAY-U – Lohian Khass + Shahkot):** 2 / 3
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Rural Report Card (PAI Performance)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered (3 Blocks):** 215
 - Mehatpur: 57
 - Lohian: 75
 - Shahkot: 83
- **Average Overall PAI Score:** 54.65 / 100
- **MLA Rural Score:** 49.2 / 90
- **Status:** C – Aspirant

Strengths:

- Panchayats show strength in **Clean & Green, Healthy Panchayat, and Child-Friendly Panchayat** themes.
- Several Panchayats performed in *Performer* band (>60).

Weaknesses:

- Assembly-wide average stuck in the **mid-50s**.
 - Persistent gaps in **Social Justice, Women Participation, and Infrastructure**.
 - None of the blocks cross 60 average.
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Health Report Card (Jalandhar District Hospital)

- **Score:** 5 / 7

Strengths:

- **Beds:** 470 available out of 603 required (22% shortage → better than many districts).
- **Doctor–population ratio:** 1:2,801 vs Punjab average of 1:3,857.
- Full OPD, diagnostics, pathology, imaging, and emergency services functional.

Weaknesses:

- **22% bed shortage** persists.
 - **Specialist shortages** (dermatology, anaesthesia, paediatrics).
 - No sanctioned **dietician or lab attendants**.
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🏠 Housing Report Card (PMAY-U – Lohian Khass + Shahkot)

- **Score:** 2 / 3

Lohian Khass (Town Panchayat):

- Houses Sanctioned: 223
- Grounded: 174 (78%)
- Completed: 140 (63%)

Shahkot (Town Panchayat):

- Houses Sanctioned: 319
- Grounded: 204 (64%)
- Completed: 157 (49%)

Interpretation: Both ULBs have **moderate progress** — >45% completion, strong grounding, but not yet high-performing.

✓ Strengths

- Panchayats perform relatively well in sanitation & greenery themes.
- Jalandhar DH has **lower bed shortages** compared to many other DHs.
- PMAY-U housing grounding rates fairly strong (64–78%).

✗ Weaknesses

- Rural governance remains in *Aspirant band* (~55 average).
- Specialist shortages & staff gaps in health infrastructure.
- PMAY completions below 65% (no full success yet).
