Overall Score:

56.4 / 100 (≈ 56%) → Grade: C (Aspirant)

- **Total Gram Panchayats Covered:** ~200 (Tanda + Bhunga)

- Majority of Panchayats clustered at **50–56**, keeping the block in *Aspirant* band.
 - **Infrastructure, women empowerment, and social justice** remain weak.

Health Report Card

- **Score:** 4 / 7

Hoshiarpur DH: Doctor-patient ratio strong, OPD & diagnostics functional. But **54% bed shortage** and **no ICU facility**.

Urmar Tanda CHC: Provides OPD & maternal services, but has **30–40% staff shortages** and limited diagnostic capacity.

- **Score:** 2 / 3
- **Investment:** ₹10.04 Cr
- **Sanctioned:** 186 houses
- **Grounded:** 77 (41%)
- **Completed:** 76 (41%)

Interpretation: Moderate progress, but less than half houses completed.

✓ Strengths

- Rural Panchayats perform moderately well on **health and sanitation themes**.
- Hoshiarpur DH has **strong doctor availability**.
- Over **40% of PMAY houses completed**, fund release ~52%.

✗ Weaknesses

- Assembly average PAI ~56 → stuck in *Aspirant band*.
 - **Severe bed shortage, no ICU**, staff gaps in health infra.
 - **Housing completion <50%**, needs acceleration.
